

National Cheng Kung University Library Rules for Use of Scanners

Approved on May 19 2009 by Library Affairs Meeting

- I. These rules are formulated with the attention to comply with the Copyright Act and to provide equal opportunities to users while using scanning facilities in the library.
- II. Users shall abide by the Copyright Act. A user may request reproduction of a part of a work that has been publicly released, or a single article from a seminar paper or a single article from a periodical that has been publicly released, provided that the copy is for personal research purposes and is limited to one copy per person. Any other regulations not stated herein are subjected to the governance of the fair use principle set forth by the Copyright Act. Users shall personally assume legal responsibility for any violation of the Act.
- III. Users who wish to use the scanner will need to register with their ID cards at the Information Desk located on the 1st floor or 3rd floor. Service time will be limited in 20 minutes if there are other patrons waiting.
- IV. User shall abide by the related rules while using scanners. Violation of the rules may lead to punishments of receiving violation points, suspension of library privileges and compensation set forth by the 「National Cheng Kung University Library Rules for Reader Violations」.
- V. These rules shall be approved by the Library Affairs Committee before they become effective. Any revisions shall be processed accordingly.
